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Specific guidelines:

- Manuscripts should be double-spaced on a page size of 8.5 x 11 inches. Manuscripts may not be longer than 35 pages, all inclusive.
- The first page should contain the article title, authors and affiliations, job title, and complete mailing address of the person to whom all correspondence should be addressed.
- The second page should contain an abstract of no more than 150 words.
- Mathematical expressions must be set using an equation editor; all equations are to be numbered consecutively on the right hand side of the page.
- Include all tables and figures at the end of the manuscript, but before the references:
  - Tables must be numbered consecutively. All tables should have concise titles.
  - Figures must be numbered consecutively. All figures should have concise titles. Figure captions are discouraged; figures should be adequately explained in the body of the paper.
